Dear Dr Walters,

Thank you again for the questions you have emailed regarding our proposals for the future of Wye College and my apologies for the delay in replying.

In answer to your question, a project of this scale and of national importance will require an initial investment of £300-400 million. As I explained during the meeting on 9 January, this money will come from a number of external sources, including government grants, EU grants and awards. If there is a shortfall, it will be made up from assets internal to Wye, which would mean the development of some land. At this early point in the project, I am afraid I am unable to estimate what percentage of this investment may come from the landholding.
